When is the event? Saturday October 20, 2018 from 3:30-7:00 pm

Should I bring treats? Please bring enough treats for approx 100 kids.

When should I arrive? The lots open at 3:30 pm for participants to decorate; parking attendants will direct cars into a space. The lot closes at 4:30.

When can I leave? Cars must remain stationary in the lot until the end of the event (7pm), when parking attendants will direct cars to exit one at a time.

Where do I park? Parking will be mapped out prior to the event based on the number of families that sign up. There are no reserves spots and each arriving car will be directed to the next available space. If you would like to park near a friend, please arrive together, spots will not be held for anyone.

Do I need to wear a costume? Costumes are required for children and highly encouraged for adults.

Reminders: Please remember all school rules apply. Respect the restrooms. Please inspect all treats your child receives before they eat any. No alcohol is permitted on school grounds. We love pets but ask that they stay home for this event.
