Morning Drop Off

Students who are being dropped off in the morning should be dropped off at crosswalk by the Main Office. There is a single lane (right lane) to enter and exit. As this line gets lengthy some mornings, please refrain from holding up the drop off line to change drivers.

Tardy Policy (per the DVRHS Student/Parent Handbook)

- Students are to arrive to school between 7:30 am 7:36 am
- First block starts at 7:37 am.
- At the sound of the late bell, all students must be in their respective first block class.
- Upon arriving at school after the late bell, the student must report directly to the Main Office. The Main Office will issue a pass into their first block class.
- A student is to be considered LATE if they arrive in class within the first 20 minutes of the class session. However, the student is still considered TARDY to school.
- Administrative discipline will be issued to any student who has been tardy to their first block class five (5) times or more.
- A student is considered unexcused until supporting documentation is received in the Main Office. Supporting documentation includes: health care provider, legal, religious holiday as defined by the State of NJ, family illness or death, driver's test, educational opportunities as approved by the Main Office and Principal, and suspension from school.
- Any student who arrives at school after 10:00 am UNEXCUSED will not be able to participate for that day in their activity regardless of the number of unexcused tardies accumulated.
