School Year Registration (opens 7/15/21) (*All Students must be re-registered every school year).

The <u>PowerSchool Annual Online Registration</u> will be open to register your child on 7/15/21. A PowerSchool Portal account is required for the submission. Each year parents need to re-register their children for the upcoming school year.

- Current <u>physicals</u>, <u>online registration</u>, and the annual \$40 for iPad insurance must be completed & turned into the Main Office by August 4, 2021. The \$40 iPad insurance fee may be waived if your Free and Reduced Application is approved.
- Checks can be made payable to "DVRHS."

Free and Reduced Lunch Application

Families can apply for Free or Reduced Lunch at any time throughout the school year. All information is kept confidential. The Free or Reduced Lunch Application will be available and emailed to everyone in August.

Cafeteria

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced that free breakfasts and lunches to all children has been extended through the 2021-22 school year. Del Val will be offering free meals to all students regardless of eligibility. However, the free meal component does not include extra items. Students will not be permitted to charge extra items. All extra items must be paid for at the time of purchase. Families are encouraged to use the K12 Payment System to add funds and track purchases on student lunch accounts.

Athletic/Band Registration

The <u>fall athletic season</u> officially begins on 8/9/21. Fall athletes are required to complete all aspects of the registration process prior to the deadline of 7/15/21.

- A physical dated on or after 8/10/20.
- Clearance for Athletes/Band Members <u>Everything You Need to Know</u>
- A Health History Update Questionnaire if the physical was completed on or before 5/9/21.
- <u>rSchool Athletic Registration</u> Create or login in to your parent account. Register each child for their first choice sport. If they do not make their first choice sport and they change their sport, a new <u>Health History Update Questionnaire</u> will be need to be submitted to the Health Office.
- Prior to the first practice, all athletes/band members must complete the yearly <u>PowerSchool</u> <u>registration</u>, <u>rschool registration</u>, and agree to the Random Drug Testing in order to participate.

Random Student Drug Testing

On June 22, 2015, Delaware Valley's Board of Education adopted a Random Student Drug Testing policy and regulations. Any student who participates in athletics, clubs, or extracurricular activities will need to be part of the random drug testing pool in order to participate. This also includes student privileges such as dances and senior parking. The policy, regulations, and the Random Student Drug Testing Consent and Withdrawal forms are included in the PowerSchool registration.

Information for Freshman Physicals

New Jersey Department of Education requires a physical exam for every student entering a new district within 30 days of entering. Delaware Valley Regional High School has the right to exclude any child who does not turn in a current physical within 30 days of entry.

For the 2021-2022 school year:

- 9th grade students must have a <u>physical</u> that was completed on or after September 2, 2020 and must be submitted by September 30, 2021.
- A sports physical will fulfill the requirement of the 9th grade <u>physical</u> if it is current on the first day of school, completed on or after September 2, 2020.
- Students from outside the district must submit a physical that was completed within 365 days of their entry date.
- Please visit the Health Office for health forms and immunization requirements.

Lockers

- All students will be assigned a hall locker, with a built in combination lock.
- Any student who has difficulty with the locker, should report it to the Main Office.
- Freshmen will receive their locker information at OASIS on August 24th.
- Each student is encouraged to bring in a separate combination lock in order to lock possessions for physical education class.
- Courts have ruled that lockers ARE the property of the school and that a search of a locker is
 justifiable if the purpose of the search is to protect the health and safety of the students, school
 personnel, or the school premises.
- DVRHS reserves the right to conduct a search for illegal contraband/paraphernalia via administration or a search dog.

Bus Passes

- Bus passes will only be issued for emergency/special situations.
- Bus notes need to be dropped off first thing in the morning to the Main Office.
- Two notes are required; one from each parent.
- Upon approval from the Principal, students will be issued a bus pass.

- The graduation ceremony will be held on Friday, June 17th at 10:00 am.
- There are unlimited tickets for an outdoor ceremony; however, for an indoor ceremony, there is a limit of 4 tickets per family.

Senior Parking

Class of 2022 Senior Driving Packet

To qualify for a parking permit, a student must have:

- 1. A valid driver's license and insurance card.
- 2. A current vehicle registration in DRIVER OR RELATIVE'S NAME
- 3. 12th grade status.
- 4. Please make sure to mark your RDT form as a yes when registering your student electronically.
- 5. In lieu of the traditional driving assembly, students and parents are required to watch a safe driving video. The video link will be available and posted on the DVRHS website between Aug. 2nd Aug. 12th.

Students who won the Marking Period 1 & 2 lottery may begin to register their vehicle information beginning sometime in August. An email will be sent out to students letting them know which day they can pick their spot and receive their parking sticker. The parking fee of \$50 has been waived for the 2021-2022 school year only.
