# National Junior Honor Society

## Criteria for Five Pillars

### Criteria

**This criterion should not be used as a checklist, it serves as a description overview for each pillar.**

#### **1. Scholarship**

- Cumulative GPA, 3.75 (Must maintain a 3.75 GPA up to Selection Date)

#### **2. Leadership**

- Leader in the classroom or in other school or community activities such as athletics, band, chorus
- Inspires positive behavior and is dependable
- Exercises positive influence on peers in upholding school ideals and spirit

#### **3. Service**

- Volunteers and provides dependable and well organized assistance
- A minimum of 10 hours of service undertaken at school or in the community
- Must have verifiable contact information
- Works well and assists others

#### **4. Character**

- School service & leadership
- Trustworthy, respectful, responsible, fair and caring
- Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty, academic integrity, and reliability
- Complies with instruction and rules and displays personal responsibility

#### **5. Citizenship**

- Understands the importance of civic engagement
- Demonstrates mature participation and responsibility through involvement with activities such as scouting, community organizations, or school clubs
