ALEXANDRIA TOWNSHIP PARENT AND SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Each parent and spectator will ensure that his/her conduct is that of a responsible adult or youth who are positively encouraging all participants to the limit of his/her ability. To meet these responsibilities, each parent and spectator is expected to:

- Respect the rules of the game.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of contest officials. Do not dispute the official's call.
- Maintain control of his/her emotions and avoid the use of abusive language, and gestures of ill temper, and refrain at all times from making hostile or negative remarks about the opposing team.
- Refrain from the use of controlled substances before, during, and after the game.
- Respect all Alexandria Middle School and Visiting Team coaches and staff.
- Leave school grounds in a timely fashion after the conclusion of a game.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game whether you win or lose. Do not interact negatively with fans, coaches, game officials or players of the home or opposing team.
- Realize, accept, and practice the principle that a team's reputation is built not only on it's playing ability, but also on the sportsmanship, courtesy, and citizenship of it's fans.

Any person found to be demonstrating unbecoming or inappropriate behavior that interferes with the contest, will be removed from the premises.
