About the Program

- Grades 5-8
- October 7th - June 1st
- Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
- 3:40-5pm
- AMS Media Center

Purpose

- Mandatory attendance for students who did not complete meaningful and purposeful homework assignment(s)
- Voluntarily attendance for students who may need extra assistance with homework assignment(s)

Outcomes

- Student completion of homework assignments
- Increase student achievement
- Receive additional support and assistance

How the Program Operates

- Teachers identify students who are missing any homework assignment(s) throughout the week
- Parent & student are notified of missing assignments via email on Friday
- Student has Friday, Saturday, and Sunday to complete assignment(s) to turn in by 3:30pm on Monday

Deadline

- If the assignment is not turned in by the deadline, 3pm on Monday, your child must attend the program Tuesday
- Both parent and student will be notified via email on Monday if your child must attend

At the Program

- During the session, your child will be monitored on completion of assignment
- If work is completed with time remaining, student will be provided supplemental work
- If work is NOT completed, student will be able to finish the work at home. Work must be handed in the next day during homeroom to the appropriate teacher. Incomplete work will result in attendance of the program that day.
- Any disruptions will result in a warning or a detention as per the School Code of Conduct.

Deadline

- If the assignment is not completed at the program, but finished at home, it must be turned in by homeroom the next day

Volunteers

- If your child wants to voluntarily attend the program, a volunteer form needs to be signed and returned a day in advance of the session
- These forms are located in each student's homeroom classroom
- They must be turned into Mrs. Milford, Mrs. Romanella, or Dr. Ferrante

Substitute

- If the teacher is absent, it is your child's responsibility to turn in the assignment to Mrs. Milford, Dr. Ferrante, or Mrs. Romanella.
- The assignment does not get turned into the substitute.

Parent Responsibilities

- Use PUP to let office know child is staying by 11 AM
- Check email daily
- Pick up child promptly at 5 pm
- Encourage & support child to complete homework assignments
- Check teacher webpages for daily assignments

Reminder

- Please remind your child to turn in the assignment(s)
- In homeroom each day, teachers will remind the students to turn in any assignments for the homework program
