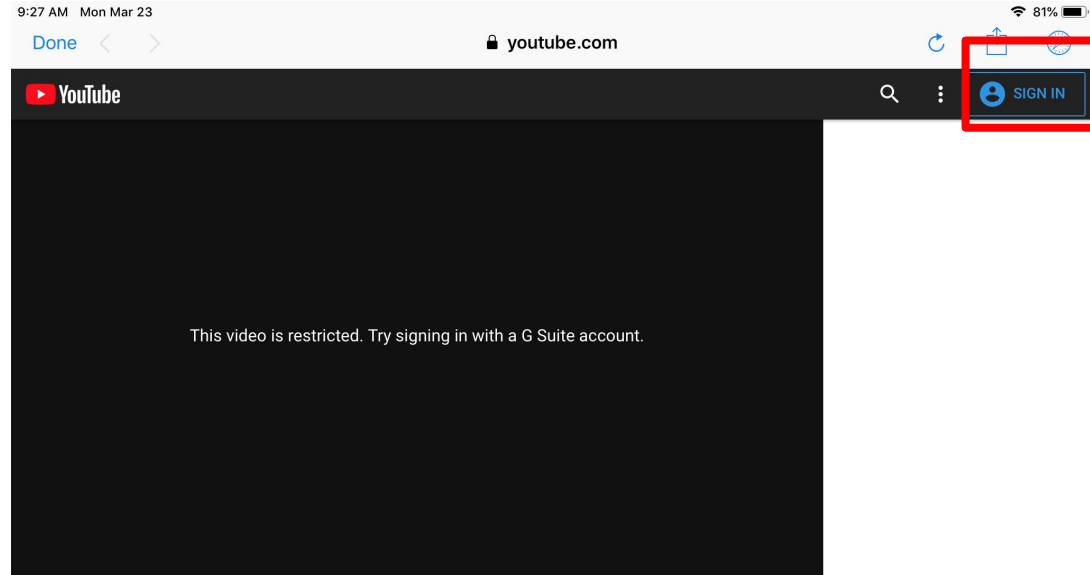


- Go to your Google Classroom & tap on the assignment.
