For parents, Knights Unite will run like a regular school day. For the staff and students, we will be running on an abbreviated schedule to free up the last two hours of the day. Lunch will still be served; it will just be earlier than normal in order to allow time for all of our activities including a pep rally. The day will end with a school pep rally.




