Solve for x.

$$(-5)^2 = (-5)(-5) = 25$$

$$1) \sqrt{x^2} = \sqrt{25}$$

$$x = 5, -5$$

$$x = \pm 5$$

$$2) \sqrt{x^2} = \sqrt{81}$$

$$x = \pm 9$$

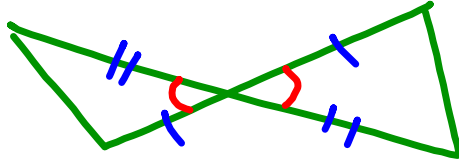
$$3) \sqrt{x^2} = \sqrt{64}$$

$$x = \pm 8$$

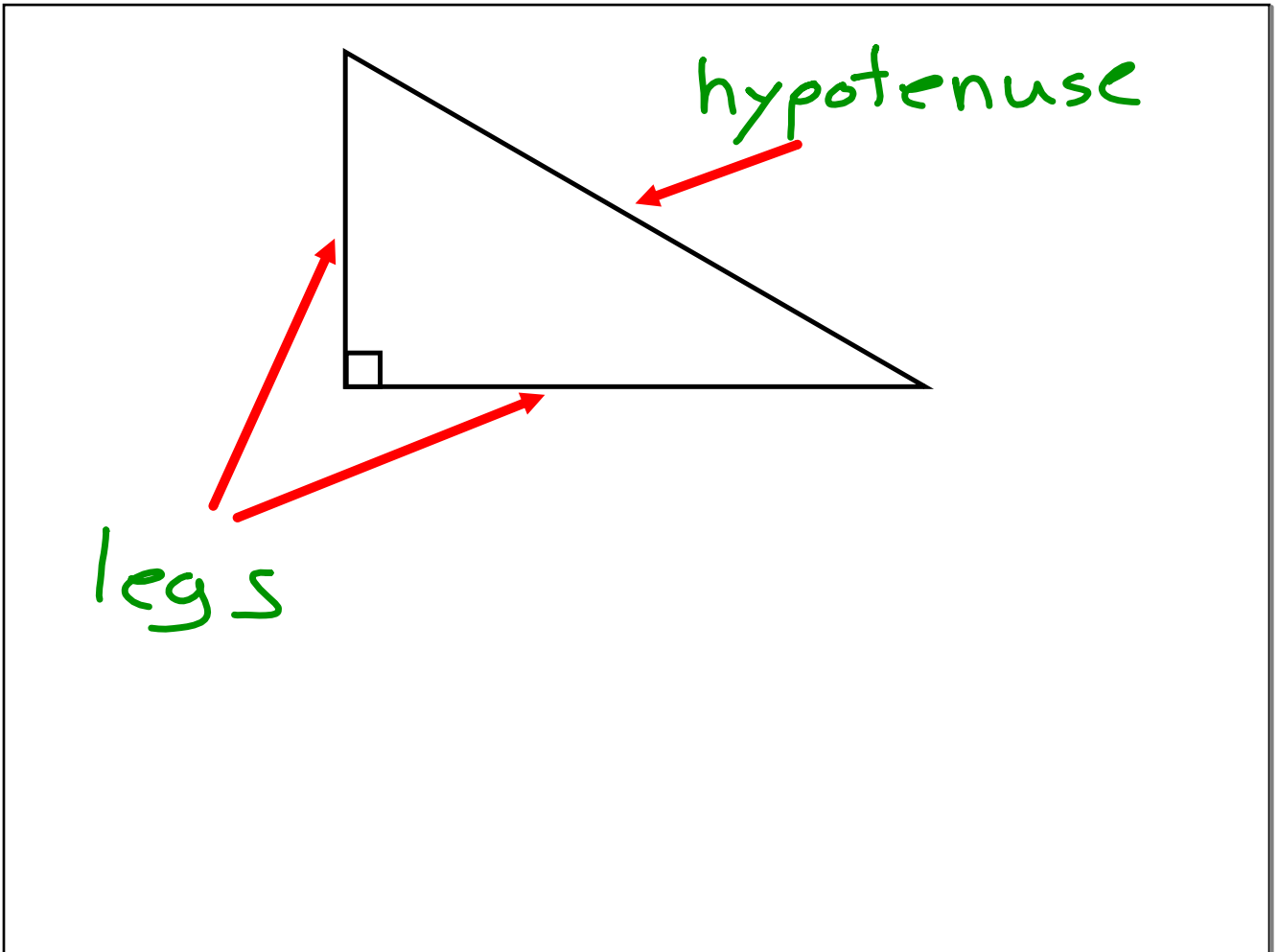
