Frenchtown School District Asbestos Management Plan

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR 763 requires all schools from pre-K to Grade 12 to conduct inspections to determine if they contain asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). If they do, the ACBM must be categorized according to the type of material, its locations, current damage, and its potential for future damage; and, a detailed Asbestos Management Plan must be developed. The Management Plan details the inspection findings and outlines the response actions the School Board intends to implement.

To accomplish these goals, the School now has on file in the Main Office a NJ State Department of Health approved Asbestos Management Plan for all school facilities. The provisions of the plan are being implemented in a timely and on-going fashion. Our Board provides a safe and healthy facility for all students, employees, and visitors.

The purpose of this memorandum is to satisfy the requirements of AHERA for written notice of the availability of the Management Plan for review.

The Public is welcome to review of copy of the Asbestos Management Plan in the business office of the school during regular business hours. The Frenchtown School District Asbestos Management Plan is monitored and overseen by RK Environmental, and the Frenchtown Elementary School has not had any asbestos abatements in recent years.

RK Environmental continues to conduct the District's EPS AHERA Asbestos Management Plan for 6-month periodic surveillance re-inspection, as well as the 3-year re-inspection. The last 6-month Asbestos Inspection was conducted in May 2017, and the last 3-year Asbestos Inspection was conducted in November, 2017. No foreseeable abatements are planned or scheduled for the school district.
