

## HOW TO ENROLL

To have your child considered for enrollment, contact Mrs. Sue Miller at (908) 995-4349.

All children must be at least age 3 by October 1<sup>st</sup> and should be toilet trained. To enroll a child, parents must provide proof of residency, along with a birth certificate and record of immunizations.

Limited space is available; therefore, residents are not guaranteed entry into the program. Enrollment of general education students is based on available openings.

## **THE PROGRAM**

Milford Public School offers a structured, nurturing preschool experience to children ages three to five. The preschool class operates five days per week from 8:30 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.

Our class provides enriching experiences designed to foster language, motor, and social development, along with academic readiness and creativity. Exposure to special area subjects such as art, music, and gym is a part of the preschool day. The program has also been established to provide any necessary supports to eligible preschool students who have been identified by the Child Study Team with special needs.

## **TEACHING STRATEGIES**

### **GOLD**

Milford Public School utilizes the Teaching Strategies Gold which is an authentic, ongoing, observation-based assessment system with 38 research-based objectives for development and learning.

### **CREATIVE CURRICULUM**

Milford Public School also uses Creative Curriculum, which is a comprehensive, research based curriculum that features exploration and discovery as a way of learning, enabling children to develop confidence, creativity and lifelong critical thinking skills.



## **OUR STAFF**

Milford's preschool program is staffed by a dual-certified elementary school teacher with experience in early childhood development. A classroom aide is also present to provide support in the classroom. Occupational and physical therapy, along with speech/language services are available to eligible youngsters with special needs.

## **PROGRAM COST**

The cost of full day enrollment for regular education students is \$475.00 per month for five full days per week.
