

**Frenchtown Elementary School
iPad Protection Plan 2021-2022**

The Frenchtown Elementary School recognizes that with the implementation of the 1:1 iPad initiative there is a need to protect the investment by both the District and the Student/Parent. The following outlines the various areas of protection: warranty, accidental damage protection, insurance and pledge agreement.

School District Protection

School District Protection will be available for students and parents to cover iPad replacement in the event of theft, loss, or accidental damage. **The protection cost is \$40.00 annually for each iPad with a maximum cost of \$120.00 per family. This plan will include one replacement. Additional replacements will cost the student/parent the full value of an iPad (\$379.00).** Parents will need to purchase this insurance through the Frenchtown Elementary School office before students are allowed to check out an iPad with the following exceptions:

- \$40 fee is waived for homeless/transplanted students
- \$40 fee is waived if you receive free and reduced lunch
- \$40 fee is waived/reduced if you apply to the Superintendent for additional circumstances/hardships

Personal Home or Homeowners coverage

Students or parents may wish to carry their own personal insurance to protect the iPad in cases of theft, loss, or accidents. Please consult with your insurance agent for details about your personal coverage of the iPad. You will need to show proof of insurance to the school before the student(s) is/are allowed to check out an iPad.

I agree to pay for the replacement of the iPad at a cost not to exceed \$379.00 should the iPad be stolen, lost, or damaged in any way.</p>
<p>Personal Insurance</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content; margin: 10px auto;">Parents Initial Here</div>	<p>I will cover the iPad under my own insurance policy, agree to pay the District the amount received from my insurance company plus any additional amount needed to cover the iPad replacement not to exceed \$379.00. Proof of the insurance will be provided to the school before an iPad is checked out to my student. Most insurance policies only provide in-home coverage. My policy must provide coverage wherever my student takes the iPad (home, school, car, etc.).</p>
<p>School District Protection</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; width: fit-content; margin: 10px auto;">Parents Initial Here</div>	<p>I choose to pay the school district an annual protection payment for coverage of theft, loss or damage by fire/flood, water in the amount of \$40.00. The family maximum will be \$120.00 for family coverage when there are three or more children in school using iPads. The \$40.00 payment is non refundable. This annual coverage begins upon receipt of the payment and ends at the conclusion of each school year. Checks should be made out to Frenchtown Elementary School.</p>

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: *In cases of theft, vandalism and other criminal acts, a police report, or in the case of fire, a fire report MUST be filed by the student or parent for the protection coverage to take place. A copy of the police/fire report must be provided to the principal's office.*

INTENTIONAL DAMAGE: *Students/Parents are responsible for full payment of intentional damages to iPads. Warranty, Accidental Damage Protection, or School District iPad Protection DOES NOT cover intentional damage of the iPads.*

Individual school iPad tablets and accessories must be returned to the Frenchtown Elementary School technology department at the end of each school year. Students who graduate, are expelled, or terminate enrollment at Frenchtown Elementary School for any other reason must return their individual school iPad on the date of termination. Devices not returned within 7 days of student withdrawal from the district will be reported as stolen and will become a student obligation. Grades will be withheld until all student obligations are met.

Frenchtown Elementary School District Acceptable Use of Technology 2021-2022

Any student, staff, or community member seeking to use the technological resources of the district must sign an **Acceptable Use of Technology** form to ensure that he/she will not attempt to acquire data for purposes not related to the educational goals of the school. This form must be signed by the student's parent/guardian, by staff and community members using the facilities.

These terms and conditions supersede all prior oral or written agreements and understandings. Any student, staff or community member that does not submit a signed Acceptable Use of Technology form **will not** have access to the computers or related technologies available in the school. All users are prohibited from the following actions:

- Using technology for illegal activities such as downloading or installing personal, inappropriate or illegal software as outlined in federal or state law.
- Disrupting, vandalizing or gaining unauthorized access to equipment, software, files or the operation of any system and/or violating copyrights or otherwise using the intellectual property of another individual or organization without permission or citation.
- Obtaining or creating pornographic text, graphics, or photographs.
- Using abusive or obscene language to send hate mail, harass another individual, violate the law or school policy.
- Using technology for personal financial or business gain.
- Logging on to the network or sending e-mail using another's identity.
- Developing bulletin boards, chat groups, or e-mail broadcasting.

Students are given storage space on the network to save their **school related work**. This storage space belongs to Frenchtown Elementary School and is not guaranteed to be private. Using the space to store non-school related files is a violation of the Acceptable Use of Technology agreement. Messages related to or in support of illegal activities may be reported to the authorities. In the event that there is a violation, the consequences will follow the existing student conduct code. If students use the Internet, computer, email or any other means to copy another user's material, both or all members will receive the same discipline. It is important that each user safeguard his/her work.

Parent/Guardian Consent (Grades PK-8)

I have read and understand the Acceptable Use of Technology Policy for Frenchtown Elementary School. I have read and discussed with my child the implications of the student's use and the penalties involved for violating the policy and have witnessed my child's signature.
