Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Prom will be held on Saturday, June 3, 2017, from 6:30 – 10:30 pm at the Bridgewater Marriott. Discounted Prom tickets are **\$80.00 per person** and will be sold on **March 14th** and **March 15th** during unit lunch. On March 14th only seniors may purchase ticket(s). On March 15th juniors and seniors may purchase ticket(s). Cash or check (payable to DVRHS) is accepted for payment. If students do not purchase a ticket(s) on March 14th or March 15th, they may purchase ticket(s) on **April 25th** and **April 26th** at the full price of **\$95.00 per person**.

To purchase tickets students must complete and sign a permission form. All students must be in good academic and disciplinary standing, and free from outstanding obligations. If you believe that your child owes money for an obligation, please pay that obligation by March 9th. All tickets must be purchased separately, even if students plan to attend as a couple. Tickets are not transferable to another student and may only be used by the purchaser. After the date of purchase, students have 24 hours to return ticket(s) for a refund. **No refunds will be issued after that time passes.**

Seating for all students will be selected on April 25th and 26th. Seniors must first purchase a ticket, and then they will have first choice of where they would like to sit. When students select seats, they will be permitted to choose one seat for themselves and one seat for their date.

Any student who intends to invite an out-of-district guest must have the guest approved by the Principal before purchasing a ticket for that guest. As soon as the student knows that he/she will be inviting and out-of-district guest, they should submit the completed form to the Principal's office (note additional "Prom Guidelines" below.)

On the evening of the Prom, the doors will open at 6:00 pm for students to check in, and students will not be admitted into the dance after 7:00 pm. This is a semi-formal event, which means NO jeans or sneakers will be permitted. Gentlemen should wear pants and a dress shirt (suits/tuxes are not necessary.) Women may wear long or short dresses, compatible with the school dress code, or a skirt/slacks and dress shirt.

## **Prom Guidelines**

- Students must bring their photo ID for check-in and to be admitted to Prom.
- Students may not bring water bottles, other containers, or bags into the dance.
- After students check in, they must stay in the building for the entire event. Any student that leaves the building for any reason may not return.
- Guests who are not yet in high school, or are age 21 and over, are not permitted to attend.
- Administration reserves the right to deny a guest request for any reason.
- Students are expected to follow and adhere to all school policies and procedures including the school dress code.
