How The Fly (Feeding Local Youth) Program Works:

Children who qualify for free or reduced lunch at school also qualify for the FLY Program.

Friday afternoons during the school year, backpacks holding lunches and age-appropriate activities such as puzzles and coloring books are delivered to Lambertville Public School for children to take home for the weekend. Similarly, in the summer, they are able to pick up a week's worth of lunches at the food pantry or at Lambertville's Parks and Recreation Camp.
