7. **APPROVAL OF PRELIMINARY 2021/2022 BUDGET**

2021-2022 School Budget

7.1 Approval of the 2021-2022 Preliminary School Budget:

WHEREAS, the 2021/2022 preliminary budget includes sufficient funds to implement the proposed planning process as described in this district's Annual Report pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7A -11 and to provide curriculum and instruction which will enable all students to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards;

WHEREAS, the 2021/2022 preliminary budget is in compliance with the requirements set forth in N.J.S.A. 18A and N.J.A.C. Title 6 and 6A;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Frenchtown Board of Education approves the 2021/2022 preliminary General Fund budget in the amount of \$2,673,020 and authorizes its submission to the Hunterdon County Superintendent of Schools for approval as follows:

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the maximum travel allowance for the 2021/2022 school year shall be established at \$5,000 and the maximum regular business travel amount shall not exceed \$1,500 per employee.
